

Fruit Trees 2021

Name	Description
Almond Garden Prince	A delightful little tree which is both highly ornamental and very productive. Beautiful pink spring blossom develops into medium sized sweet nuts enclosed in soft, well sealed shells. 1.5m
Apple Braeburn	Delicious, crisp, juicy flesh and superb sweet-tart flavour with a noticeably aromatic aftertaste. Excellent keeper. Late season. Spur bearing. Harvest May
Apple Cox's Orange	Dessert apple with yellow flesh, skin red-stripped over green. Aromatic flesh has a slight nutty taste. Good keeper. Ripens February.
Apple Fuji	Fuji is a large, sweet, crisp, fine textured, and complexly flavoured apple. This vigorous tree produces excellent eating fruit that store very well. Late season. Tip bearing
Apple Granny Smith	Granny Smith produces a large green fruit with a tart, well balanced flavour and crisp, juicy white flesh. It crops late in the season and has a long picking period. Harvest May
Apple Monty's Surprise	This versatile apple is hardy variety which cooks well. Originating from a very old tree in the Manawatu, this apple ripens late in the season. The skin has a shiny red stripe over a light green background.
Apple Red Delicious	Red Delicious is a heart-shaped fruit with a striking bright red skin that is sometimes striped. The flesh is crunchy and very juicy with a mild, sweet flavour.
Apple Braeburn Dwarf	Dwarf M26 rootstock. Delicious, crisp, juicy flesh and superb sweet-tart flavour with a noticeably aromatic aftertaste. Excellent keeper. Late season. Spur bearing. Harvest May. 2m
Apple Granny Smith Dwarf	Dwarf M26 rootstock. Granny Smith produces a large green fruit with a tart, well balanced flavour and crisp, juicy white flesh. It crops late in the season and has a long picking period. Harvest May. 2m
Apple Splendour Dwarf	Dwarf M26 rootstock. Beautiful, large, carmine-red apples with creamy, very crisp flesh. Sweet and very low acid. Ripens late and hangs well on the tree. Fabulous winter keeper. Tip and spur bearing. 2m
Apple Royal Gala/Braeburn	Royal Gala, Creamy, fine textured flesh, is crisp, sweet and juicy. Matures in mid summer. Tip bearing. Braeburn It has delicious, crisp, juicy flesh and superb sweet-tart flavour with a noticeably aromatic aftertaste. Excellent keeper. Late season.
Apple Granny Smith/Red Delicious	Granny Smith produces a large green fruit with a tart, well balanced flavour and crisp, juicy white flesh. Harvest May. Red Delicious, heart-shaped fruit with a striking bright red skin that is sometimes striped. The flesh is crunchy and very juicy with a mild, sweet flavour. Harvest Feb-April
Apple Gala/Fuji	Royal Gala, Creamy, fine textured flesh, is crisp, sweet and juicy. Matures in mid summer. Fuji is a large, sweet, crisp, fine textured, and complexly flavoured apple. This vigorous tree produces excellent eating fruit that store very well. A late season apple. Both tip bearing
Apple Royal Gala/Braeburn/Granny Smith	Royal Gala, Creamy, fine textured flesh, is crisp, sweet and juicy. Braeburn It has delicious, crisp, juicy flesh and superb sweet-tart flavour with a noticeably aromatic aftertaste. Granny Smith produces a large green fruit with a tart, well balanced flavour and crisp, juicy white flesh. Harvest May
Apple Royal Gala/Braeburn/Splendour	Royal Gala, Creamy, fine textured flesh, is crisp, sweet and juicy. Matures in mid summer. Braeburn It has delicious, crisp, juicy flesh and superb sweet-tart flavour. Excellent keeper. Late season. Splendour Beautiful, large, carmine-red apples with creamy, very crisp flesh. Sweet and very low acid.
Apricot Fitzroy	A medium sized fruit with golden coloured skin with sweet and juicy flesh. A consistently heavy cropper. Self-Fertile and matures in February.
Apricot Garden Annie	An early season fruiting variety, with good sized bright yellow fruit that are firm and juicy as well as being semi-freestone. A highly ornamental tree that is semi-dwarf
Apricot Moorpark	Freestone variety that has superbly flavoured fruit that are medium to large in size. Skin is deep yellow with orange blush that's fuzz free. The soft and juicy flesh allows the fruit to be suitable for fresh eating, bottling or drying. A mid-season variety best suited for cooler climates
Apricot Newcastle	Large crops of ripe orange-coloured, sweet fruit. One of the best home garden dessert varieties. Freestone. Hardy. Ripens November/December

Apricot Royal Rosa	A very early, freestone selection with firm tasty gold flesh, yellow skin with a red blush. A disease hardy, low chill selection recommended for home gardens. Nov/Dec
Apricot Sundrop	Excellent cropper of large oval, yellow skinned fruit that are freestone with sweet and juicy flesh that ripens over a long season. Can be eaten fresh or used for preserving. Sundrop is Partially self-fertile. Harvest Jan
Apricot Trevatt	Large, sweet, and juicy, this golden yellow fruit ripens mid to late in season. Perfect for eating as well as bottling. Harvest Jan
Cherry Compact Stella	Heavy reliable bearer of large, dark-red fruit with firm flesh. Self-fertile and one of the best known sweet cherries. Ripens December/January.
Cherry Dawson	Delicious eating cherry with firm red flesh encased in rich black skin. Fruit is of medium size, ripening December. Tree habit is upright and spreading.
Cherry Lapins	Large dark red fruit with firm juicy flesh. This precocious variety is now a commercial mainstay in many areas. Fruits in warmer areas of New Zealand, ripening Dec-Jan
Cherry Rainier	Large, super-sweet cherry, typically larger than its red counterparts. White/yellow fruit with red blush. White flesh is firm with a smooth texture. Requires cool winters to set fruit. Great pollinator. Early/mid season, ripening in December.
Cherry Sam	Produces large sized fruit that are blackish-red in colour and sweet, juicy red flesh with excellent flavour. Ideal for eating fresh from the tree, bottling and freezing. Resistant to cracking and needs to be pollinated by another variety such as Compact Stella, Lapins, Stella. Mid-season harvest December.
Cherry Summit	An early to mid season dark red cherry. It is a very large flat heart-shaped fruit with excellent flavour. Has dark red skin, light red, juicy flesh. Pollinate with Compact Stella, Lapins and Stella.
Cherry Sam/Summit	Sam Produces large sized fruit that are blackish-red in colour and sweet, juicy red flesh with excellent flavour. Ideal for eating fresh from the tree, bottling and freezing. Summit An early to mid season dark red cherry. It is a very large flat heart-shaped fruit with excellent flavour. Has dark red skin, light red, juicy flesh.
Malus Gorgeous	Round-headed tree. Branches are festooned with white blossoms in spring. Spectacular crops of bright crimson-red fruit hang like cherries on long thin stalks. 3mx3m
Malus Ionensis Plena	Spectacular very large, fragrant double pink flowers delight in spring followed by greenish yellow fruit. Small, vase shaped tree. Has high drought resistance. 2 x 2m
Malus Jack Humm	Brilliant large red crab apple flushed yellow and orange. Strong growing vigorous tree. Ideal for jellies and preserves. Gives a magnificent display right into winter. Deciduous. Hardy.
Nashi Hosui	Excellent eating, sweet, juicy with good acid balance and fine texture. Large russeted golden brown fruit. Partially self fertile. Mid season harvest Feb Mar
Nectarine Goldmine	Medium sized white-fleshed freestone fruit that is juicy and sweet. Mid season Jan harvest. An old favourite variety which is very productive. Tree is vigorous.
Nectarine Red Gold	A large, proven late season (Feb) nectarine with a sweet flavour, rivalling some peach varieties. Deep red skin with gold blush and a deep yellow flesh that easily separates from the stone.
Nectarine Snow Queen	An excellent variety that produces large sized fruit that has pale coloured skin flushed with red. Flesh is white, sweet and juicy. Freestone, self-fertile and early-season.
Nectarine Flavour Zee	A dwarf nectarine with mid season yellow fleshed fruit of good size and eating quality. Forms a compact bushy habit. Self fertile but best with another nectarine or peach in the vicinity
Nectarine Garden Delight	Large juicy freestone fruit with red skin and yellow flesh. Low chilling. Attractive large pink blossom. Harvest Feb/Mar
Nectarine Nectar Babe	Sweet, yellow, juicy, freestone flesh. Deep pink blossom. Low chilling requirement. Best planted with Honey Babe or near another nectarine or peach to aid pollination. Harvest Feb
Peach April White	A delicious white firm fleshed large peach that has an attractive pink blush. The tree is of medium vigour with a high resistance to Leaf Curl. Heavy cropper late in the season.
Peach Black Boy	Port-wine flesh, very sweet and juicy. Popular for eating fresh off the tree and bottling. Freestone. Skin is red to black. Heavy cropper, shows some resistance to leaf curl. Great home garden peach. Ripens March/April.
Peachcot	Golden late season fruit that are very sweet and tasty with a firm, meaty texture. An attractive red blush on the skin develops on the sun-exposed side of the fruit. Harvest Jan

Peach Healy's Peacharine	Excellent eating and great bottler. Actually a nectarine/peach cross. Medium to large firm fruit with smooth skins. Sweet and juicy yellow flesh. A late season clingstone variety.
Peach Coconut Ice	Large, round-oblate fruit with light pink colour skin and white flesh. Harvest Jan
Peach Golden Queen	A true favourite peach, great for bottling and an excellent eater. Firm, deep-orange flesh. Clingstone. Late season, ripens March/April.
Peach Freestone Queen	This sport of the ever popular 'Golden Queen' peach differs in that it is 'freestone' which means that the succulent yellow flesh separates easily from the stone. The outer skin is golden with just a little blush of red. Ripens late February.
Flatto™ Peach Sweet Cap™	white fleshed variety with excellent flavour - delicious when eaten while still crunchy, or equally tasty when left to soften slightly. The fruit has a very small stone, which is very easy to eat around. 4m
Peach Hiawatha	An unusual Peach tree in that it has long narrow maroon leaves that are very striking. The usual pink blossom in spring followed by tasty, small, purple skinned peaches with orange flesh.
Peach Bonanza	Dwarf yellow freestone peach with red blush. Large, sweet fruit, low in acid, with a mild, refreshing flavour. Highly attractive in both blossom and fruit. Harvest Jan/Feb
Peach Garden Lady	Dwarf peach. Large yellow skinned fruit with sweet, juicy yellow flesh marked red. Freestone. Partially self fertile. Harvest Mar
Dwarf Peach Honey Babe	Medium to large fruit with orange, sweet juicy flesh and tangy flavour. Showy pink flowers. Fruits best near other peaches or nectarines for cross pollination. Harvest Feb
Dwarf Peach Pixzee	Large red over orange skinned fruit with delicious, firm, yellow flesh. Freestone. Early to ripen. Vigorous to 1.8m. Harvest Dec/Jan
Pear Beurre Bosc	Fruit has a golden russet colour, and is sweet, buttery and juicy. Pollinate with 'Conference', 'Williams Bon Chretien' or 'Doyenne du Comice'. Mid season cropper, ripens February/March
Pear Garden Belle™	Deliciously sweet flavoured fruit with smooth, soft flesh texture, green and mildly russeted skin. Ripens in mid summer and stores well. The first truly dwarf pear variety growing to 3m tall. Needs cross pollination with another Pear or Nashi.
Pear Packams Triumph	A large irregular shaped pear with greenish-yellow skin. It has finely textured, white, sweet tasting flesh and is an excellent dessert and bottling pear. Pollinators - Beurre Bosc, Williams bon Chretien or Durondeau.
Plum Billington	First plum with dark red skin and flesh to ripen. Crops heavily around Christmas. All purpose plum with good sweet flavour. A Cross variety. Self fertile.
Plum Black Doris	An excellent all purpose plum. Fruit is of medium size, with purple black skin and dark red sweet, juicy flesh. Ripens February. Pollinators include Billington, Duff's Early Jewel, Elephant Heart and Santa Rosa.
Plum Elephant Heart	Very large heart shaped fruit with dark red extremely sweet & juicy flesh. Superb freestone plum. Mid to late season. Japanese variety. Good pollinator.
Plum Hawera	Highly recommended New Zealand selection of plum with large, very dark red skin and fleshed fruit. Freestone, sweet, juicy and very firm. Mid season. Self fertile.
Plum Luisa	Mid-season plum with yellow skin and flesh that is almost freestone. Aromatic, fine flesh, juicy and sweet if well ripened on the tree. Relatively disease resistant. Self Fertile.
Plum Omega	Green and red-skinned, red-fleshed, large, high-quality dessert fruit. The fruit is very juicy and sweet. Partially self-fertile but will pollinate with 'Billington', 'Burbank', 'Duff's Early Jewel', 'Elephant Heart' or 'Santa Rosa'. Ripens February/March.
Plum Coe's Golden Drop	Super mid to late season plum. Large oval, yellow fruit both rich in taste and with juicy flesh. European variety. Best planted with a Greengage.
Plum Damson	A highly productive variety of small tart oval fruit with blue skin and yellow flesh. Best eaten when fully ripe or used for bottling. A compact grower that is best in colder areas. Expect fruit once tree is 3-4 years old. Self fertile.
Plum Billington/Omega	Billington: First plum with dark red skin and flesh to ripen. Crops heavily around Christmas. All purpose plum. Omega: Green and red-skinned, red-fleshed, large, high-quality dessert fruit. The fruit is very juicy and sweet

Prune Stanley	Prolific producer. Dark blue skinned smaller fruit with sweet and juicy golden flesh. Self-fertile and useful pollinator. Fruit is bigger and sweeter if the crop is thinned while small. Late season.
